The New York International Music Competition was established to encourage young artists to pursue their study in music; to support them in showcasing their talent in world class venues; and to provide them with opportunities to collaborate with elite orchestras and ensembles. We encourage all talented youth to demonstrate their musical potential.

Final Round:

Sunday, May 12, 2019 at 2:00pm

Three finalists will be chosen to each perform a movement from a concerto with the New York International Chamber Orchestra in the final round. The rehearsal will be held on Saturday, May 4 from 7:00pm-9:00pm. Soloists must attend the rehearsal in order to perform in the final round.

Preliminary Round

The contestants' preliminary performances will be auditioned and judged via DVD submissions or via on-line format.

LOCATION:

Weill Recital Hall at Carnegie Hall

ELIGIBILITY:

Pianists, violinists, violists, cellists, winds and brass players of ages 9 - 16 (as of May 1st, 2018).

How to Apply:

- 1) Complete application form.
- 2) YouTube (or other video sharing sites) link to the video recordings or a DVD of their performance (no need to mail a DVD if a YouTube link is provided).
- 3) A biography of the applicant in Word format (not to exceed 150 words). Include past participation in competitions, festivals and/or other public events.
- 4) Portrait photo in electronic format, to be used for the competition brochure printing.

APPLICATION DEADLINE:

All application documents and DVD recordings must be received by mail on or before April 15, 2019.

DIVISIONS & REPERTOIRE:

PIANO:

- 1. One fast movement of a concerto from the Baroque, Classical or Romantic period (Bach, Mozart, Beethoven, Chopin, Mendelssohn, Grieg, Saint-Saens, Schumann and Liszt) AND
- 2. One solo work selected by the contestant from a different period.

STRINGS:

1.First or last movement of a concerto from the Classical or Romantic period (Haydn, Mozart, Beethoven, Lalo, Bruch, Popper, Elgar, Wieniawski and Mendelssohn)
OR a substantial showpiece that can be played with an orchestra (works by Saint-Saens, Sarasate, Wieniawski, etc)

WINDS/BRASS:

- 1. One fast movement of a concerto with orchestral cuts, including of cadenza.
- 2. One movement from a different period.

REQUIREMENTS:

- 1) All contestants must perform from memory.
- 2) Absolutely no simplified editions or arrangements.
- 3) Contestants are required to bring original music to the rehearsal (NO photocopies).
- 4) Judges' comments will not be disclosed.
- 5) Contestant must perform with an accompanist in their preliminary round video.
- 6) Contestant's video must be authentic without editing. It must be recored within four weeks prior to the application submission. Artistic director reserves the rights to terminate any collaboration with soloists after the first orchestra rehearsal.
